- (a) whether the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) has recently issued guidelines regarding the standards to be adopted to test the medicines by AYUSH;
- (b) if so, the manner in which these guidelines are being implemented;
- (c) the details of emerging fields of research to which the said guidelines are related;
- (d) whether the Government has any mechanism to ensure compliance of these guidelines; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?
