CCTV AT STATIONS

1408. DR. K. GOPAL:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is true that many Railway Stations in the country lack CCTV cameras;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether it is also true that in many railway stations not a single CCTV camera has been installed;**
- (d) if so, whether the Railways has taken a decision to cover all the railway stations with CCTV cameras; and**
- (e) if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

(a) to (e): Presently, 394 railway stations have been provided with Close Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras over Indian Railways, which includes 106 railway stations where CCTV cameras have been installed under Integrated Security System (ISS). A total of 202 railway stations have been identified as sensitive for the purpose of installation of ISS and CCTV surveillance system is one of the components of ISS. In addition, 983 railway stations have also been identified for installation of CCTV cameras under Nirbhaya Fund.

Strengthening and upgradation of security infrastructure is an ongoing process. Accordingly, more stations will be brought under CCTV surveillance system in due course.
