ATTACKS ON INDIAN STUDENTS

1429. SHRI ABHISHEK SINGH:

Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether incidents of attacks on Indian students studying abroad have come to the notice of the Government and if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard;**
- (b) the steps taken by Central Government to ensure safety of Indian students studying abroad;**
- (c) whether any help desk or toll free number has been maintained by the Government to help such students in case of any attacks and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (d) the country-wise number of students at present studying in different foreign universities?**

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS
[GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD)]**

(a) Yes. As per information received from Indian Missions/Posts abroad, 21 incidents of attacks on Indian students from 10 countries have come to the notice of the Government during 2017. Country-wise data is placed at Annexure-I.

Missions took up the issues strongly with local police authorities and concerned ministries of the foreign countries to ensure safety and security of Indian students. Advisories were issued and placed on the website of the Indian Missions to alert the Indian students.

(b) The Ministry of External Affairs and Indian Missions/Posts abroad take prompt action to address issues pertaining to security, safety and welfare of Indian students who are enrolled in foreign universities and educational institutions.

Indian Missions are in regular contact with foreign governments, universities and educational institutions, Indian student Associations and community organizations and take all possible measures to provide assistance to Indian students in foreign countries, as and when such issues arise.

Indian Student Welfare Officers have been designated in Indian Missions, in countries where there are large number of Indian students enrolled.

Ministry and Missions also issue advisories asking them to carry all documentation and undertake due diligence to ensure that the foreign institutions to which they are seeking admission have proper authorization and capacities.

(c) Yes. 24x7 helpline numbers are available in Missions, which are placed on the Mission's website for assistance of distressed Indians including students. A comprehensive list of emergency numbers of Indian Missions is also placed on MEA website to help distressed Indians.

(d) Based on inputs received from Indian Missions/Posts abroad, a list of country-wise number of students at present studying in different foreign universities is at Annexure-II.
