- (a) whether there is any report has been submitted by any committee duly appointed by the Government which aimed to address inadequacies in addressing population-specific requirements and data collection; and

(a) & (b): The Government of India has set up a National Statistical Commission (NSC) to identify the core statistics, which are of national importance and are critical to the development of the economy. The mandate of NSC, inter-alia, includes recommendations to address inadequacies in statistics, statistical systems, etc. As and when required, the NSC also constitutes various professional Committees/ Working Groups to assist the Commission on various technical issues. These Committees / Working Groups submit their reports to the NSC for further follow-up action and recommendations. For each financial year, an Annual Report on the activities of the NSC containing, interalia, the Action Taken Report on its recommendations is laid in both Houses of Parliament.
