- (a) whether the Government of Karnataka has sent a proposal to the Railways for laying railway tracks from Bangalore-Chamarajanagar-Satyamangalam, Chikmangalur-Sakleshpura and Shimoga-Harihar on equal cost sharing basis; and**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the decision taken thereon by the Railways?**

(a) and (b): Based on the proposal/consent received from the Government of Karnataka, Hejjala(Bangalore)-Chamarajanagar portion of Bangalore-Chamarajanagar-Satyamangalam, Chikmagalur-Sakleshpur portion of Kadur-Chikmagalur-Sakleshpur and Shimoga-Harihar new line projects have been taken up on 50% cost sharing basis with the Government of Karnataka.
