- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps to strengthen the Information Communication Technology (ICT) infrastructure to avoid such data leaks and data breaches; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (d): Government has set up a Committee of Experts under the Chairmanship of Justice (Retd.) Shri B N Srikrishna to prepare a data protection framework and work out the Data Protection Bill. The Committee has prepared a White Paper on "Data Protection Framework for India" which has been published on Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology (MeitY) website soliciting public comments by 31.01.2018. The White Paper has sought public response and views on all relevant issues related to protection of personal data.
