AVAILABILITY OF DRINKING WATER

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Railways is supplying contaminated water to its passengers and staff who live in the railway colonies and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether water provided at stations and trains was not even being tested for presence of E. coli bacteria and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether cases of manipulations in the award of contracts for supply of chlorination plants for the past several years have come to the notice of the Railways;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the Government thereto; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Railways to provide safe drinking water?
