SCIENCE AND RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP SCHEME

Will the Minister of SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY विज्ञान और प्रौद्योगिकी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the salient features of the Science and Research Fellowship Scheme along with its present status;
- (b) the details of the funds sanctioned, allocated and utilised under this scheme during the last three years, State/UT-wise including West Bengal;
- (c) the details of the target set and achievements made under this scheme during the above-mentioned period along with its response;
- (d) the details of the number of countries engaged/involved under this scheme;
- (e) whether the Government is planning to make some amendments in this scheme; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

- (a) The Department of Science & Technology is implementing India Science and Research Fellowship Programme (ISRF) for researchers of the neighbouring countries (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka) to work in Indian Universities and Research Institutions for a period of 3-6 months. Twenty six fellows from 6 countries have availed the fellowship so far.
- (b) The total funds sanctioned during last 3 years is Rs. 1,25,69,350/- (Rupees one crore twenty five lakhs sixty nine thousand three hundred fifty). Out of which an amount of Rs. 85, 57,569/- (Rupees Eighty five lakhs fifty seven thousand five hundred sixty nine) has been utilized till March 31, 2017. The programme does not have any state/UTwise allocation.
- (c) & (d): Target for this fellowship programme is to provide 126 fellowships for 3 years (42 fellowships per year) to the researchers of 7 neighbouring countries (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka). Against the last 3 Calls 97 applications were received from 6 countries and 55 fellowships have been awarded on the basis of merit for the researchers from 6 neighbouring countries (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka).
- (e) & (f): No, Madam. No amendments are being contemplated at the moment. However, extension of this fellowship scheme to Thailand under the bilateral India-Thailand Programme of Cooperation in Science and Technology is under consideration.
