- (a) No, Madam.
- (b) to (d): Ordnance Factories under Ordnance Factory Board (OFB) manufacture arms and ammunition in accordance with the laid-down specifications, drawings and available Acceptance Plan. Testing / trial is an integral part of quality process. Items are issued to the User only after successfully completing the stipulated inspections, testing and proofing by Directorate General of Quality Assurance (DGQA). Damage to equipment during testing, if any, is properly investigated by Defect Investigation Team headed by DGQA and comprising representatives of the User and OFB.
