Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of patriotism based films made and broadcast by Doordarshan during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (b) whether a sharp decline in the making of patriotism based films has been observed during the past few years;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, and the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to promote patriotism based films and stop production of films depicting violence; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING [COL. RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE (Retd.)]:

(a) to (c): 36 patriotic feature films were telecast by various Doordarshan Kendras in the last three years including the current year. Year wise patriotic films telecast on DD national Channel are as under:

(d) and (e): Films Division under this Ministry has been mandated to produce documentary films on various social subjects which includes patriotic films. As per the guidelines of certification of films for public exhibition, the Board of Film Certification shall ensure that anti-social activities such as violence are not glorified or justified, pointless or avoidable scenes of violence, cruelty and horror scenes of violence are primarily intended to provide entertainment and such scenes as may have the effect of desensitizing or dehumanizing people are not shown.
