**Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:**

**(a) the details of sports associations in the country along with their purposes and targets;**

**(b) whether the Government monitors the functioning of the sports associations and if so, the details thereof;**

**(c) the short coming detected/ misconduct noticed in their functioning during the last three years;**

**(d) whether the sports associations play an important role in promoting various disciplines of sports and if so, the details thereof;**

**(e) the discipline-wise financial as well as other assistance provided to sports associations during the said period; and**

**(f) the other steps taken by the Government to promote sports in the country?**

**ANSWER**

**(a) to (f): Madam, 'Sports' is a State subject and the primary responsibility of development of Sports rests with the State Governments and the concerned National Sports Federations (NSFs).**

**The NSFs are responsible and accountable for the overall management, direction, control, regulation, promotion and development of respective sports disciplines. NSFs are required to discharge their responsibilities in consonance with the principles laid down in the Olympic Charter or in the charter of the Indian Olympic Association or the relevant International Federation. The Government only supplements the efforts of recognized NSFs through various schemes by providing financial and other support for training and participation of sportspersons/teams in international tournaments abroad, holding of national and international tournaments in India, purchase of equipment, etc. For the year 2017, Government has given recognition to 53 NSFs for development and promotion of respective sports disciplines. Financial assistance provided to various NSFs during the last three years is given in the Annexure.**

**To ensure that the NSFs adhere to the principles of good governance, Government has issued guidelines including age and tenure limits in respect of Office Bearers of the NSFs, fair and transparent elections, prevention of age frauds and sexual harassment of sportspersons, observance of RTI, etc. These guidelines are part of the National Sports Development Code of India (NSDCI), 2011. During the last three years a few NSFs were found to have violated the Government guidelines relating to age & tenure restrictions of office bearers, irregularities in the elections, etc. Government has taken action against such NSFs which included withholding of annual recognition, withdrawal of recognition, etc.**
