Work undertaken under RYSK

†1637. SHRI CHANDRA PRAKASH JOSHI:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of work undertaken under the Rashtriya Yuva Sashaktikaran Karyakram (RYSK) so far;
- (b) the details thereof and the objectives/aims of the said programme;
- (c) the components of the programme and the details of funds allocated, released and spent by the various States under the said programme since its inception, State/ UT-wise; and
- (d) the number of activities started, State/UT-wise and the number of youth who took active participation in administrative process of various States?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS [Col. RAJYAVARDHAN RATHORE(Retd.)]

(a)& (b): 'Rashtriya Yuva Sashaktikaran Karyakram (RYSK)' acts as the flagship programme of the Department of Youth Affairs for empowerment of the youth to enable them to realise their potential and in the process, to contribute to the nation-building process. The consolidation of a number of Schemes into 'Rashtriya Yuva Sashaktikaran Karyakram (RYSK)' has enabled the Department to leverage the vast field-level administrative network under Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) and National Youth Corps (NYC) for effective implementation of other components of this RYSK as well. The details and objectives of the sub-schemes of the RYSK are as under:

Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS):

NYKS undertake Core Programmes under Annual Action Plan from Block Grant of Department of Youth Affairs and also implement Schemes viz. National Young Leaders Programme (NYLP), National Programme for Youth and Adolescent Development (NPYAD) and National Youth Corps (NYC) under RYSK Scheme of Department of Youth Affairs, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.

The details of Programmes and Schemes being undertaken by Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan are as follows:

Core Programmes

- 1. Youth Club Development Programme
- 2. Training on Youth Leadership and Community Development
- 3. Promotion of Sports
 - a. Block level Sports Meet
 - b. District level Sports Meet
- 4. Skill Up-gradation Training Programme
- 5. Promotion of Folk, Art and Culture
- 6. Observance of Days of National and International Importance
- 7. District Youth Convention
- 8. Mahatma Gandhi Swachhta Abhiyan Avam Sharamdaan Karyakram
- 9. Yuva Aadarsh Gram Vikas Karyakaram
- 10. Awards to Outstanding Youth Club at District, State and National levels.

A Special Project of Slum Yuva Andolan in Delhi State has been undertaken.

The objectives of the Programmes are to select, engage, mobilize and empower youth for leadership and overall personality development, establish institutional mechanism to generate youth movement, build a cadre of committed youth and engage them in focus areas, motivate and enable to develop the empowered youth to assume leadership in addressing social and development issues, community welfare and peace building and provide youth opportunity to participate exhibit their talent and meaningfully contribute towards nation building.

It is also to empower the youth of the country to achieve their full potential, and through them enable India to find its rightful place in the community of nations.

National Young Leaders Programme (NYLP)

In pursuance to the Budget announcement during 2014-15, a new Scheme, namely, 'National Young Leaders Programme (NYLP)' was launched in December, 2014 in order to develop leadership qualities among the youth. Some significant achievements during the year are as follows:

- Neighbourhood Youth Parliament Programmes are being organized by involving NYKS-affiliated Youth Clubs with the objective of developing leadership qualities of the youth by involving them in debate/ discussions on contemporary issues. During current year, 2,047 Block level Programmes were organised, with participation of 1.76 lakh youth. In addition, 23,255 village-level neighbourhood youth parliament programmes involving 2.92 lakh youth. The Programmes organised during the first quarter of 2017-18 were effectively leveraged for Yoga Awareness and Training, in addition to other themes, which played a key role in effective participation of NYKS in Yoga programmes across the country on the 21.06.2017, i.e., the International Day of Yoga.
- Youth for Development: The Programme is being organized, to develop leadership qualities of the youth by involving them in *Shramdaan* activities. Awards are given to youth clubs doing outstanding work.

National Youth Corps (NYC):

The main objectives of the Scheme are as follows:

- To set up a group of disciplined and dedicated youth who have the inclination and spirit to engage in the task of nation-building.
- To facilitate the realization of inclusive growth (both social and economic).
- To act as points for dissemination of information, basic knowledge in the community.
- To act as group modulators and peer group educators.
- To act as role models for the younger cohort, especially towards enhancement of public ethics, probity and dignity of labour.

Youth Hostel:

Youth Hostels are built to promote youth travel and to enable the young people to experience the rich cultural heritage of the country. The construction of the Youth Hostels is a joint venture of the Central and State Governments. While the Central Government bears the cost of construction, the State Governments provide fully developed land free-of-cost, with water supply, electricity connection and approach roads. Youth Hostels provide good accommodation for the youth at reasonable rates. Under the Scheme, funds are not allocated State/UT-wise. The Youth Hostels are looked after by Managers, appointed by the Central Government. For each Hostel, a Hostel

Management Committee (HMC) is constituted to oversee the management related issues for an efficient functioning of the Hostel. The HMC is headed by a State Government functionary (Collector/ DC at the District level/ Secretary, Youth Affairs/ Sports in the State Capital). So far, 83 Youth Hostels have been constructed across the country and one more Youth Hostel, at Roing (Arunachal Pradesh), is in advanced stage of completion.

National Programme for Youth and Adolescent Development (NPYAD):

Financial Assistance to Government/ non-Government organisations.

26 organizations (State level and All India Level) have been assisted with Grant in Aid for conducting various Youth and Adolescent Development Programmes such as National Integration Camps, Inter-State Youth Exchange Programme, Multi-Cultural Activities, Career Guidance Camps, Second Chance Camps, etc.

Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Award

On 29.08.2016 i.e on Sports Day, Tenzing Norgay National Adventure Award (TNNAA) for the Year 2015 was conferred to 6 individuals for their outstanding Achievements in the different fields of Adventure. Similarly on 29.08.2017 the TNNAA 2016 was conferred to 4 individuals. The Award ceremony was held at Rashtrapati Bhawan, New Delhi.

National Youth Festival

Under the component of Promotion of National Integration, a National Youth Festival is organised during 12-16 January every year. The Festival starts on 12th January (which is also the National Youth Day), to commemorate the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda. The Programmes organised as part of the Festival include various cultural programmes (both competitive and non-competitive), youth convention, suvichar, exhibitions, adventure programmes, etc. About 5,000 youth come from all the States/UTs to participate in the Festival. The 21st National Youth Festival was organized at Rohtak, Haryana by the Ministry jointly with the Govt. of Haryana, during 12-16 January, 2017.

It was decided that during the 12th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas (PBD), 2014, the first day of the PBD, i.e. 7th January shall be celebrated as Youth PBD to bring focus on Young Pravasis. Accordingly, the Department actively associated with the event, as joint organiser along with the Ministry of External Affairs and Govt. of Karnataka.

North East Youth Festival

The 5th North East Youth Festival was organised at Gangtok, Sikkim during 28th to 30th October, 2017 with the objective to provide platform for the youth from the North-East States to come together, to share their rich cultural heritage, to interact with and learn from each other. About 1500 youth participated in the Festival.

Objectives of NPYAD Scheme:

- Engage and channelise the energy of youth in a positive manner for nation building;
- Develop amongst youth a sense of pride in nationally accepted values like democracy, socialism, and secularism;
- Promote activities and programmes, which foster social harmony and national unity among youth;
- Promote spirit of national integration, unity in diversity, pride in Indianness among the youth of different parts of the country and to induce a sense of social harmony amongst the youth;
- To motivate the youth to act as focal point for dissemination of knowledge in the rural area and involve them in nation building process;
- To stimulate action for development and empowerment of adolescents, particularly from the economically and socially neglected/backward sections of society;
- To build and develop an environment which recognises the specific needs and promise of the adolescents in the country and provides for adolescent friendly services.

International Co-operation (IC):

To create an international perspective in the youth and to involve them in promoting peace and understanding the "International Youth Exchange Programme" is being implemented by this Department. Under this programme, youth from India are sent to friendly countries and vice-versa for promoting exchange of ideas, values and culture amongst the youth and also to develop International understanding. "International Youth Exchange Programme" helps in strengthening and encouraging cooperation with various countries on matters concerning youth, through youth related events and cultural exchange programmes. During this financial year, this Department has organized youth exchange with 07 friendly countries (China, South Korea, Russia, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Vietnam and Palestine). Under this scheme, the funds allocated are not released to any of the State/UT Governments, but are utilized by the Ministry itself for implementing the scheme.

Assistance to Scouting & Guiding Organisations:

Scouting and Guiding is a component of Rashtriya Yuva Sashaktikaran Karyakaram (RYSK). It is an international movement aimed at building character, confidence, idealism and spirit of patriotism and service among young boys and girls. Scouting and Guiding also seeks to promote balanced physical and mental development among the boys and girls. The activities inter-alia, include programme related to adult literacy environment, conservation, community service, health awareness and promotion of hygiene and sanitation. The Scouting and Guiding organizations have been conducting the scouting / guiding programme to developed the skills provide physical fitness as well as proper training of disaster management to students, training camps, skill development programmes, holding of jamborees and other activities like audit literacy, environment conservation, community service, health awareness and promotion of hygiene and sanitation and other activities from time to time among the youths. The grant is given to conduct Scouting and Guiding activities all across the country. For the last three Financial Years Rs. 1.5 crore is being given for conducting Scouting & Guiding activities all across the country benefitting around 40,000 youths.

(c) The details of funds allocated, released and spent by Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan are as <u>Annexure</u>.

Under the NPYAD Scheme, there is no provision for allocation of fund Sate/UTs-wise.
