Hindrance in Implementation of SBM

1665. SHRI SHIVKUMAR UDASI:

Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION**be pleased to state:

- (a) whetherSwachh Bharat Mission(SBM) is facing socio-political resistancein sidestepping the inhuman and illegalpractice of manual scavenging and if so,the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Union Government isgranting funds to different States to achievethe objectives of SBM; and
- (c) if so, the details of the funds thathave so far been provided to various Statesduring each of the last three years and thecurrent year, State-wise?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF DRINKING WATER & SANITATION (SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)

- (a) No, Madam. The Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin)SBM (G) was launched on 2nd October, 2014, which aims at attaining Open Defecation Free India by 2nd October 2019. As per SBM (G) guidelines para 5.4.6 "Construction of "insanitary latrines" as defined "The prohibitions of Employment As Manual Scavenger and Rehabilitation Act, 2013" at Para 2.(1) (e) is not permitted in the rural areas. The existing "insanitary latrines" if any, should be converted to sanitary latrines and the sharing pattern for incentive for the targeted beneficiaries shall be identical to that of construction of individual house hold latrines
- (b) Yes, Madam.
- (c) State/UT-wise, central share released under SBM (G) during last 3 years and current year is at Annexure-1.
