- (a) whether the Government has inaugrated the first ever Ayurveda Hospitals on the lines of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) in New Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with amount incurred thereon;
- (c) whether the Government has also launched the All India Institute of Ayurveda, if so, the details and objectives thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has asked/issued guidelines to private companies to contribute a part of their Corporate Social Responsibility funds for setting up of Ayurveda Hospitals and developing Yoga, if so, the details thereof and response of the companies thereon; and
- (e) the other steps taken/being taken by the Government for AYUSH led health revolution in the country?

(a) to (c): All India Institute of Ayurveda has been established at Sarita Vihar, New Delhi as an Autonomous Body under Ministry of AYUSH on All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) pattern at a cost of Rs. 157.00 crore. The institute has been dedicated to the Nation by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India on 17th October, 2017.

AIIA is a 200 bedded referral hospital and shall impart Post Graduate (PG) and Ph.D degree courses in Ayurveda. First batch of Post Graduate course has been started in 2016. Institute has also started Out-Patient Department (OPD) and In-Patient Department (IPD) facility with major specialties in Ayurveda.

ANNEXURE IN REPLY TO PART (e) OF THE LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 167

- (i) Ministry of AYUSH has set up Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences for undertaking coordination formulating, developing and promoting research on scientific lines in Ayurvedic sciences through medicinal plant research (Medico-ethno botanical survey, pharmacognosy and tissue culture), Drug Standardization Pharmacological Research, Clinical Research Literary Research and Documentation. The activities of the Council are carried out through 30 institutes / Centres/ Units located all over India and also through collaborative studies with various universities, hospitals and institutes.
- (ii) The Ministry of AYUSH also notified National AYUSH Mission (NAM) on 29.09.2014 which envisages better access to AYUSH services though upgradation of AYUSH Hospitals, Dispensaries, setting up of co-located AYUSH facilities and 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital; strengthening of AYUSH educational institutions, facilitate the enforcement of quality control of Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani & Homoeopathy (ASU & H) drugs and sustainable availability of raw materials for ASU & H drugs in the State/ UTs.
- (iii) Central Council for Research in Yoga & Naturopathy (CCRYN), New Delhi, an autonomous organization under the Ministry of AYUSH has a Collaborative Research Centre to verify the efficacy of Yoga & Naturopathy in various diseases.
