1696. SHRI RAVNEET SINGH:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated to the State of Punjab under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) during the financial years 2016-17 and 2017-18;
- (b) the details of number of houses constructed and likely to be constructed in the State, District-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has appointed a third-party organization to undertake evaluation and audit of the quality of construction and work done under the said scheme;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the audit mechanism that the Government follows for such construction; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

(a) : The central allocation to the State of Punjab under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) for the financial year 2016-17 is Rs. 18322.329 lakh and for the financial year 2017-18 is Rs. 4953.310 lakh.

(b): A statement indicating houses allocated and constructed under PMAY-G in the State of Punjab district-wise is given at Annexure-I.

(c) to (e): No Madam. However, as per Framework for Implementation of PMAY-G, monitoring of scheme is envisaged at the level of Government of India, State/ UT Government levels, through community participation and through IT enabled e-governance platform, through Area Officer visits, National Level Monitors (NLMs),Programme Management Unit (PMU) of the State/UT, District Development Coordination and Monitoring Committee (DISHA) and through Self Help Group (SHG) network under NRLM, NGOs, Civil Society Organisations (CSOs) and Social Audit.
