Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the total number of persons imparted skill training under the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya-Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) till October, 2016, State-wise including Telangana;
- (b) the details of total persons getting placements under DDU-GKY till October, 2016, State-wise;
- (c) whether the persons got placement are in alignment with the target set by the Government and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the corrective steps taken by the Government to improve the placement scenario?

(a) & (b): State-wise number of persons imparted skill training and placements under DeenDayalUpadhyayaGrameenKaushalYojana(DDU-GKY) from April 2014 till October 2016, including Telangana are as below:-

(c): The placement target for DDU-GKY is 70% of trained candidates. Currently, the placement achievement is at 52%. However, as a placement linked skill development program, funding is allowed to Project Implementing Agencies under DDU-GKY on achievement of 70% placement of trained candidates. Where placements are between 50-70%, funding is reduced proportionately to the extent of placement achievement and remaining cost has to be borne by the Project Implementing Agency.

(d): Placement is a function of employment market. DDU-GKY primarily targets skilling of unemployed rural poor youth to improve their employability. Thus employment is not generated in DDU-GKY, but candidates are given jobs after employment / job opportunities have been created through market forces and / or other interventions by government. However, in order to ensure quality sustainable jobs, Ministry has entered into MOU with 12 Champion Employers.
