Directorate of Advertising and Visual Publicity being a nodal advertising agency of the Government of India caters to the requirement of the Ministries / Departments through various media vehicles and as per their directions frequency/number of insertions are decided accordingly. As Cinemas is a state subject, Ministry of Information & Broadcasting has advised State Governments to ensure mandatory screening of Public Service Awareness (PSA) films during the screening of commercial cinema in theatres as per the provisions of Cinematograph Act, 1952. The Digital Service Providers have also been requested accordingly as they are also covered under the said Act.

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
