Funds for Construction of Toilets

†1796. SHRI JAI PRAKASHNARAYAN YADAV:

Will the Minister of **DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is providing funds to the States for construction of toilets in every householdin order to eliminate open defecation inrural areas;
- (b) if so, the details of funds releasedduring each of the last three years and thetotal number of rural villages which havebeen made open defecation-free, State/ UTwise;
- (c) whether it is a fact that funds are being misappropriated in the name of construction of toilets in many States including Bihar; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and themanner in which the Government proposesto achieve the targets under Swachh BharatMission-Gramin?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF DRINKING WATER & SANITATION (SHRI RAMESH CHANDAPPA JIGAJINAGI)

- (a) The Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) (SBM(G)) has been launched on 2nd October, 2014, which aims at attaining Swachh Bharat by 2nd October 2019. The focus of the scheme is on behavior change and usage of toilets. Under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), there is a provision of an incentive of Rs. 12,000 for the construction of Individual household latrine (IHHL) to all Below Poverty Line (BPL) households and to identified Above Poverty Line (APL) households (all SCs /STs, small and marginal farmers, landless labourers with homestead, physically handicapped and women-headed households).
- (b) State/UT-wise, Central share released under SBM(G) during last 3 years (Rs. in Crore) and No. of villages declared ODF is at Annexure-1.
- (c) Sanitation is a State subject and the SBM(G) programme is implemented through the States/UTs, therefore, as and when complaints are received, they are immediately forwarded to respective States/UT Governments for appropriate corrective measures.
- (d) Under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), since launched on 2.10.2014, 5.74 crore toilets have been constructed. As on 26.12.2017, 4.25 crore households are without toilets in rural areas and expected to be covered with toilets by 2.10.2019.
