- (a) the details of the number, names and length of National Highways in Karnataka along with those that are proposed to be converted to four and six lane highways;
- (b) the details of funds provided to Karnataka for repair and maintenance of the National Highways passing through the State during the last three years;
- (c) whether the Government has received any proposal from the State Government of Karnataka for repair of all National Highways passing through Karnataka during the last three years and current year;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS  
(SHRI MANSUKH L. MANDAVIYA)

- (a) There are 39 number of National Highways passing through the State of Karnataka having length of 6991 km including sections / stretches which are proposed to be converted to Four / Six lane.
- (b) During the last three years Rs.479 crore has been provided under Maintenance & Repair of National Highways in the State.
- (c) to (e) During the last three years and current year the proposals for repair of National highways passing through Karnataka were sanctioned for Rs. 446 crore .
