## **Development of Keshod Airport**

(a) whether the Government proposes to develop Keshod airport near Gir forest sanctuary of Gujarat to improve air connectivity;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the steps taken by the Airports Authority of India (AAI) to enable operation of scheduled flights from Keshod airport?

## ANSWER

(a) to (c): Keshod airport is an operational airport suitable for operation of ATR-72 / ATR-42 type of aircraft. Development / upgradation of airports is a continuous process and is undertaken by Airports Authority of India (AAI) from time to time depending on the availability of land, commercial viability, socio-economic considerations, traffic demand / willingness of airlines to operate to/from such airports, etc.

It is, however, up to the airlines to provide air services to specific places subject to compliance of Route Dispersal Guidelines (RDG) issued by Government. No airline had submitted proposals for operation of Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) flights from Keshod airport in the first round of bidding under RCS UDAN.
