Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to sanction Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC) in the country particularly in Malabar Cancer Centre, Kerala;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a) to (c): There is no proposal to sanction Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC) in the country particularly in Malabar Cancer Centre, Kerala.

However, under the strengthening of Tertiary Care for Cancer scheme of National Programme for Parvention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Diseases and Stroke (NPCDCS), in the State of Kerala, Government of India has approved one State Cancer Institute (SCI) at Regional Cancer Centre, Thiruvananthapuram, and one Tertiary Care Cancer Centre (TCCC) at Government Medical College, Kozhikode.
