Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government has received any proposals/requests from Chhattisgarh for upgradation of medical college at Jagdalpur-Bastar to super speciality hospital;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the decision taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) to (c): Yes. Government Medical College, Jagdalpur has been approved by Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs on 03.08.2016 for the upgradation under Phase-IV of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY). The cost approved for GMC, Jagdalpur is Rs. 200 crore with Central share constituting of Rs. 120 crore and State share constituting of Rs. 80 crore.
