NEW HOSPITALS UNDER PMSSY

1934. SHRI RAVNEET SINGH:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of hospitals sanctioned and made operational under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY);
- (b) whether the Government has undertaken an evaluation to match the need for hospitals against existing health care services, district-wise and State-wise, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any study to evaluate proper utilization of funds under the PMSSY; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

- (a): The Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) aims at correcting the imbalances in the availability of affordable tertiary healthcare facilities in the different parts of the country in general, and augmenting facilities for quality medical education in the underserved States in particular. This Central Sector Scheme has two components:
- i. Setting up of new AIIMS-like institutions (including Hospital) at 20 places; out of which six (6) AIIMS set up under Phase-I of PMSSY at Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Jodhpur, Patna, Raipur and Rishikesh are functional.
- ii. Up-gradation of existing 73 nos. of State Government Medical College/Institutions (GHC/Is) by creating a Super Specialty Block (SSB) or Trauma Centre.

The details of AIIMS Hospitals & SSB/ Trauma Centres in Govt. Medical Colleges sanctioned and made functional are given in Annexure-I.

(b): There was no evaluation study conducted by MoHFW to match the needs for hospital against the existing Healthcare services. However, three tier system of health care infrastructure (Sub Centre, Primary Health Centre & Community Health Centre) has been developed in rural areas by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare as per the following population norms:
