- (a) whether the New Development Bank setup by BRICS countries has approved its financing plan including two infrastructure projects in China and India; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

(a) and (b): The New Development Bank (NDB) does not have any pre-approved project financing plans. The project proposals are submitted by the BRICS nations for financing by the Bank. The Bank, after due-diligence and approval processes, considers the project proposals on case-by-case basis for approval. In respect of China and India, the New Development Bank has approved financing of fours projects each. The details of these projects are in the Annexure.
