# LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 2006 TO BE ANSWERED ON 29.12.2017

### WORKING WOMEN HOSTELS

#### 2006. SHRI SANJAY HARIBHAU JADAV:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the Government is implementing the scheme for Working Women Hostels, if so, the salient features and norms of scheme:
- (b) the funds sanctioned, released and utilised under the scheme during each of the last three years and the current year, State/ UT-wise;
- (c) the number of hostels presently operational in the country including Maharashtra, State/UT-wise;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to increase the number of such hostels in the country, particularly in tribal areas and North-Eastern States in view of increase in demand and if so, the details thereof;
- (e) the number of proposals received by the Government under the scheme alongwith details of new hostels sanctioned and constructed during the said period, State/UT-wise; and
- (f) whether a number of proposals for construction of hostels are lying pending with the Government, if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise along with the action taken for their clearance?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WOMEN & CHILD DEVELOPMENT (DR. VIRENDRA KUMAR)

- (a) Yes. Working Women Hostel Scheme aims at providing safe and affordable accommodation to working women. These hostels have Day care facility for the children of inmates too. The Ministry provides financial support for establishing such hostels by NGOs or State Governments. The cost sharing ratio amongst the Central Government, States/ UTs (other than NE and Himalayan States) and Implementing Agencies will be 60:15:25 for construction of building for Working Women Hostel/ running hostel in rented premises. For NE and Himalayan States, the ratio will be 65:10:25.
- (b) State/ UT-wise details of fund released under the scheme during the last three years and current year as per details given in **Annexure-I**.
- (c) Since its inception in **1972-73**, **958** hostels have been sanctioned under the scheme of Working Women Hostel all over the country. State-wise list of sanctioned working women's hostels is at **Annexure-II**.
- (d) The Ministry provides financial support to proposals for establishing such hostels by NGOs or State Governments. The proposals are approved and supported as and when they are submitted to the Ministry.
- (e) During the last three years and the current year, 69 new proposals have been received under the Scheme and 54 new hostels have been sanctioned as per details given in **Annexure-III**.
- (f) No. The Scheme has been revised. With the revision of the funding pattern of the Scheme, the grant under the scheme will be released directly to the State Governments / UT Administrations.
