(a) to (c) : The Department of Economic Affairs had constituted an Inter-disciplinary committee to examine the existing global regulatory and legal structures governing Bitcoin; to take stock of the present status of Bitcoin both in India and globally; suggest the frame work for regulation of Bitcoin if among others etc. The committee has submitted its report which is under consideration of the Government. The Reserve Bank of India has also cautioned from time to time, vide their Press Releases dated December 24, 2013 and February 1, 2017, the users, holders and traders of Bitcoin about the potential financial, operational, legal, customer protection and security related risks.
