ESTABLISHMENT OF SAKHI CENTRES

210. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY KOTHA:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any proposal from the State of Telangana regarding establishment of Sakhi Centres in the newly established districts in the State;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the action taken by the Government on the proposal along with the quantum of funds earmarked and released thereunder; and
- (d) the time by which these centres are likely to be established?

ANSWER

- (a) to (d): The Ministry is implementing Scheme for setting up One Stop Centre since 1st April 2015 to support women-affected by violence. Under the scheme, it has been envisaged that One Stop Centre would be set up across the country in phased manner. In the first phase, one Centre was sanctioned per State/UT. Further, 150 additional Centres are taken up in second phase during 2016-17. Recently, the cabinet has approved for setting up 150 additional districts during the year 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20.

The Ministry has approved a proposal of Telangana for setting up One Stop Centre in Hyderabad during 2015-16 for which an amount of Rs.45,88,047/- was sanctioned during 2015-16. Further, in second phase during 2016-17, the proposal of setting up 8 OSCs in Adilabad, Karimnagar, Khammam, Mehabubnagar, Nalgonda, Nizamabad, Warangal and Medak of Telangana were approved and an amount of Rs.1,55,31,600/- was released. All these centres are functional.
