#### **AYUSH OPD CLINICS**

#### 218. SHRI KONDA VISHWESHWAR REDDY:

Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY(AYUSH) be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of AYUSH OPD clinics set up at Primary Health Centres during each of the last two years, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the details of amount sanctioned, disbursed and utilised for the purpose during the said period;
- (c) whether there is shortage of AYUSH professionals at OPD clinics; and
- (d) if so, the corrective measures taken by the Government in this regard along with sanctioned and actual strength available at the said clinics?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

- (a) & (b): Since Health is a State subject, the setting up of AYUSH OPD clinics at Primary Health Centres comes under the purview of State Government. However, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) grant-in-aid has been provided under the component of co-location of AYUSH facilities at Primary Health Centres (PHCs). The details of amount sanctioned, disbursed and utilised for the purpose during last two years, State/UT-wise is furnished at **Annexure.**
- (c) & (d): As Health is a State subject, the information on shortage of AYUSH professionals at OPD clinics in the country is not maintained by the Central Government. Under National Health Mission (NHM), financial and technical support is provided to States/UTs to strengthen their healthcare systems including support for insourcing or engagement of doctors on contractual basis, based on the requirements posed by the States/UTs in their Programme Implementation Plans (PIPs) within their overall resource envelope.

Further, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), financial support is provided to the States/UTs at co-located AYUSH facility at Primary Health Centres (PHCs) for infrastructure, medicine and contingency purpose.
