NORTH-EAST CITIES UNDER HRIDAY

Will the Minister of HOUSING & URBAN AFFAIRS be please to state:

- a) the reasons for not including cities of North-East under HRIDAY
 Scheme;
- b) whether the Government plans to include any city from North Eastern Region under the scheme in the future; and
- c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT/CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING & URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a) to (c) The Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY) scheme was launched only on a pilot basis for 4 years upto November, 2018. Only 12 cities, Amritsar, Ajmer, Amaravati, Badami, Dwarka, Gaya, Kancheepuram, Mathura, Puri, Varanasi, Velankanni and Warangal were selected. The Government has decided to discontinue the scheme after November, 2018, therefore, no new cities are likely to be selected.
