Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is formulating any scheme for beautification of New Delhi and Lutyens Bungalow Zone (LBZ);
- (b) if so, the expenditure likely to be incurred for the said work; and
- (c) the time by which said work is likely to be started?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a) to (c): The New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) has intimated that the improvement of parks, public spaces and fountains in its area is taken up on regular basis. An expenditure of \gtrless 1.25 crores (approx.) is to be incurred during the year 2017-18.

The Central Public Works Department (CPWD) has intimated that it has plan to install colorful musical fountain in two water channels and in water body around canopy near India Gate and colorful static fountains in twelve water channels in central vista area, New Delhi at an estimated expenditure of \gtrless 45.00 crore. The work is likely to be started by April, 2018.
