## Minority Status to Jews

2607. SHRIMATI POONAM MAHAJAN:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:
(a) the total population of Jews in India, State wise;
(b) whether the Government has recognised the need to grant minority status to the members of the Jewish community in the country;
(c) if so, the details thereof;
(d) whether members of the Jewish community have received minority status in the States of Maharashtra and West Bengal; and
(e) if so, the rationale behind granting minority status to Jews by the said States?

## ANSWER

## MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKHTAR ABBAS NAQVI)

(a) There is no separate categorization of Jews in the population Census 2011. They have been included in the category of "others", therefore, exclusive population figure of Jews as per census 2011 is not available. However, the State/UT wise population of Jews/Judaism religious community as per Census 2001 is attached at Annexure-I.
(b)\&(c) So far, the Central Government has not granted minority status to the Jewish community.
(d)\&(e) Central Government declares a communities as 'Minorities’ under Section 2(c) of National Commission for Minorities (NCM) Act, 1992 in the context of India as a whole. Declaration of minority community within the State is the subject matter of the State Government concerned. As per information made available by NCM, State Government of Maharashtra has declared Jews as Minority while State of West Bengal has not declared Jews as Minority.
