HOUSING FOR ALL IN VILLAGES OF GUJARAT

2789. SHRIMATI RANJANBEN BHATT:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to complete its dream project of housing for all at the earliest;
- (b) if so, whether the Government proposes to provide housing for all in all villages of Gujarat; and
- (c) if so, the number of villages covered and proposed to be covered under the said scheme in the State and the time frame for the same and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

(a) to (c): With the commitment to provide "Housing for All" by 2022, the erstwhile rural housing scheme Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY) has been restructured into Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G) w.e.f. 1st April, 2016. Under PMAY-G, in the initial phase, 1.00 crore houses are proposed to be constructed for all the eligible beneficiaries, comprising of houseless households and households living in zero, one or two room houses with kutcha wall and kutcha roof, in rural areas of the country including all villages of Gujarat over the period of 3 years from 2016-17 to 2018-19.
