Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that 100 MBBS students of RIMS, Ongole, Andhra Pradesh are not able to get degrees in spite of completing their MBBS course since MCI refused to give confirmation certificates;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to resolve the issue and protect the interest of students?

(a) to (c): On the recommendation of Medical Council of India (MCI), the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare issued Notification on 20.11.2017 recognizing MBBS Degree (100 seats) granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students trained at Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Ongole.
