Operation of Flights from International Airports

(a) whether there are certain airports which have been given international status but no international flight operates from these airports;

(b) if so, the details regarding the number and names of these airports along with the reasons for the same; and

(c) whether any action is being taken to start international flights from these airports and if so, the details thereof?

(a): Yes, Madam.

⁽b) & (c): At present, no international flights are operating from Imphal, Vijayawada, Tirupati, Portblair, Srinagar, Patna and Aurangabad airports. Indian carriers are free to mount services from any point in India to foreign destination as per the respective bilateral air service agreements. However, actual operations are always guided by traffic demand and commercial judgement of airlines.
