- (c) whether such financial assistance is provided for the development of backward districts in the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PANCHAYATI RAJ (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- (a) & (b): Yes. Financial Assistance has been received through World Bank assisted projects for strengthening of Panchayati Raj system in few States of the country. These World Bank assisted projects focused on strengthening the decentralization in the spirit of the constitution and developing the institutional systems and capacities of the Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) with the ultimate objective of improving the service delivery systems at the local level. The details of World Bank assisted ongoing projects for strengthening Panchayati Raj System in the Country is at Annexure.
- (c) & (d): Financial assistance for these projects are for strengthening of Panchayats, and not specifically for the development of backward districts.
