HOUSING FACILITY TO BEED! WORKERS

292. SHRI PARTHA PRATIM RAY:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government has taken any steps to provide housing facility to beed workers in the country;
- (b)if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the funds allocated for the purpose during the last three years and the current year and the number of workers likely to be benefited therefrom, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) & (b): Yes Madam, Ministry of Labour & Employment has formulated Revised Integrated Housing Scheme (RIHS), 2007, which has now been revamped to RIHS, 2016, which is applicable to the workers engaged in Beedi/Iron Ore Mines, Manganese Ore & Chrome Ore Mines (IOMC)/Limestone Ore Mines, Dolomite Ore Mines (LSDM)/Mica Mines and Cine Industries, registered with the Labour Welfare Organisation (LWO).

In the current scheme, a housing subsidy of Rs. 1,50,000/is released in three installments in 25:60:15 ratio. First installment
(25%) of the subsidy i.e. Rs. 37,500/- per tenement is released as
advance, the second installment (60%) of the subsidy i.e. Rs. 90,000/is released on reaching the lintel level and the third installment (15%)
i.e. Rs. 22,500/- per tenement is released after the construction of the
house has been completed.

(c): The funds allocated during the last three years and current year are as mentioned below:
