(a) to (c): The institutional and financial structure for various Industrial Corridor Projects in the country including Chennai-Bengaluru Industrial Corridor (CBIC) project was approved by the Union Cabinet on 7th December, 2016. The Government is taking forward the development of CBIC Project in coordination with concerned State Governments. The process relating to detailed master planning and preliminary engineering has been initiated for the Krishnapatnam node identified in the State of Andhra Pradesh under CBIC Project. The construction related activities will be initiated after completion of the project development activities and after the land is made available by the concerned State Governments.
