300. SHRI UDAY PRATAP SINGH:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether many Small Scale Industries have been shut down in the country during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefore, ,State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the measures taken/being taken by the Government to revive them?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR MICRO, SMALL & MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI GIRIRAJ SINGH)

(a)&(b): As per the provisional data released by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) the number of sick micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) in March, 2016 was 4,86,291. The State/Union Territory-wise position regarding the number of sick units for the years 2014, 2015 and 2016 is given in annexure.

As per the final report of Fourth All India Census of MSMEs, the main reasons for closure are stated to be (1)Lack of demand, (2)Shortage of working capital, (3)Non availability of raw materials, (4)Power shortage, (5)Marketing problems, (6)Labour problems, (7)Management problems, and (8)Equipment problems.

(c): Framework for revival and rehabilitation of the MSME units has been put in place under the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006.
