HPV VACCINE

3029. SHRI PRASUN BANERJEE:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any plans to introduce HPV vaccine under the universal immunisation programme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the said vaccine will help in preventing cervical cancer and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

- (a): Currently there are no plans to introduce Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine in the Universal Immunization Programme.
- (b): In view of above, the question does not arise.
- (c): Yes, Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine will help in preventing cervical cancer. Long term infection with HPV type 16 and HPV type 18 are associated with 80-83% of cervical cancer. As per World Health Organisation (WHO) position paper on HPV vaccine, published in May 2017, available HPV vaccines are helpful in prevention of cervical cancer.
