SHORTAGE OF STAFF IN AIIMS

3042. SHRI RAM CHARITRA NISHAD:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the emergency wing of AIIMS, New Delhi which gets over 500 patients daily is short staffed and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the availability number of senior residents and junior residents is far less than their required/sanctioned strength and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of technicians for ECG and ventilator services is also less than required and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to fill up the vacancies?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

- (a) & (b): the Emergency wing is adequately staffed but there is a shortage of some nursing staff. Senior Residents of other departments are rotated in the Department of Emergency Medicine for patient care.
- (c) & (d): No. Filling up of posts is a continuous process. Special recruitment drives and walk-in-interviews are also held as and when required.
