Development of Buffer Zones

3071. SHRI RAGHAV LAKHANPAL:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has developed buffer zones for conservation of environment in the country; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise?

(a) and (b) The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change under subsection (1) read with clause (v) and clause (xiv) of subsection (2) of section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) read with sub-rule (3) of rule 5 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, notifies Eco-Sensitive Zones around National Parks and Sanctuaries for protection of environment and biodiversity. The Eco-Sensitive Zones also act as buffer in protection to the rich biodiversity inside the National Parks and Sanctuaries. As on date, the State-wise details of Eco-Sensitive Zones notifications issued are at **Annexure**.
