**GST LITERACY UNDER PMKVY**

**Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP  
be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether any support has been provided under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) to create a GST literate workforce that can assist smaller enterprises for their GST filings and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) the details of the curriculum of the courses, number of people trained and duration of the course, State-wise ?

(a) and (b) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, in consultation with Department of Revenue, Central Board of Excise & Custom (CBEC), and National Academy of Customs, Indirect Taxes & Narcotics (NACIN) under Ministry of Finance, had finalized a roadmap to execute a training program for GST under MSDE's flagship program Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY). The candidates trained under this program provide support to small and medium enterprises/entrepreneurs for filing their returns under GST.

To execute this training, Banking Financial Services and Insurance Sector Skill Council (BFSI SSC) under the supervision of MSDE, developed a 140 hour (including 40 hours of digital literacy) course called the GST Accounts Assistant Training. The job role is a level 4 course as per National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) and is duly validated by industry experts. Under PMKVY (2016-20), 4375 candidates have been trained under GST. The State-wise details are given at **Annexure**.
