(a): The Labour Code on Wages has been introduced in Lok Sabha on 10.08.2017 and subsequently, referred to the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Labour.

(b) & (c): Intra-Ministerial discussions with concerned organizations are part and parcel of any amendment in Labour Law. The Code on Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions is at present pre-legislative stage.
