**YOGA EDUCATION**

**3178. SHRI B. SRIRAMULU:**

Will the Minister of **AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH)** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of yoga centres functioning and professionals registered at present, State/UT-wise along with the details of criteria adopted for certification of these yoga centres;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to spread yoga education through various levels of courses in the country and if so, the details thereof, course-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has made any plan to train a large number of youths in yoga and send them to various countries to spread yoga and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the other efforts made by the Government to provide visa facilities to international students for long duration yoga courses and promote yoga as a lifestyle science instead of academic subject?

**ANSWER**

**THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA,

(a): Ministry of AYUSH through its two autonomous organizations namely the Central Council for Research in Yoga and Naturopathy (CCRYN) and Morarji Desai National Institute for Yoga (MDNIY) run various OPDs/ Yoga centres details of which are given at **Annexure**.

Quality Council of India (QCI) at the behest of Ministry of AYUSH has developed a Scheme for Voluntary Certification of Yoga Professionals. The Focus of the scheme is to certify the competence of Yoga professionals providing Yoga lessons/classes as Yoga Instructors/ Yoga Teachers or by any other nomenclature. Scope of certification has been categories as (i) Level 1- Yoga Instructor (ii) Level 2-Yoga Teacher (iii) Level 3-Yoga Master (iv) Level 4-Yoga Acharya (v) Level 5- Yoga Guru. Out of these, certification for two Levels namely Level-1 and Level-2 have so far been launched.

(b): Yes. The Ministry of Human Resource Development has taken action to spread yoga education through the following courses in Colleges and Universities through UGC, based on the recommendations received from a Committee set up by them for Yoga in Education in June, 2016 as detailed below:

(c): No such large scale training of youth in Yoga for sending them to various countries has been planned. However Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) has been deploying Yoga teachers to teach Yoga at its cultural centres abroad. In 2017 Teachers of Indian Culture (TIC)s have been posted to many more Missions abroad all over the world. At present 53 Yoga Teachers are deployed at various Indian Missions/Posts abroad. Ministry of AYUSH is sending Yoga Teachers for a short period during International Day of Yoga (IDY) through ICCR.

(d): Ministry of AYUSH had constituted an accreditation committee to draw guidelines for accreditation of Yoga Institutes/Centres under different categories. One of the objective of this accreditation process is to facilitate VISA to international students in the accredited Yoga Institutes/Centres.
