Will the Minister of **AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH)** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of registered practitioners under AYUSH system of medicines in the country, State/UT-wise and stream-wise;
- (b) the details of institutions/ hospitals imparting medical education in AYUSH at various levels in the country, State/UT-wise and stream-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to open/upgrade AYUSH institutions, colleges, universities, hospitals, health centres, research centres in the country, State/UT-wise and streamwise;
- (d) whether the Government has received a number of proposals from various States in this regard and if so, the details thereof along with action taken thereon;
- (e) the details of funds earmarked, allocated and utilized for the purpose during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise; and
- (f) other efforts being taken by the Government to promote education under AYUSH system of medicines in the country?

- (a): The number of Registered Practitioners under AYUSH system of medicines in the country, State/UT-wise and stream wise is given at **Annexure-1**.

(b): The details of AYUSH colleges/institutions imparting medical education at various levels in the country, State/UT-wise and stream-wise is given at **Annexure-II**.

(c) & (d): Since, Health is a State Subject; the Opening/upgradation of AYUSH Hospital comes under the purview of concerned State/UT Government. However, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), there is provision of financial assistance for setting up of upto 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital and upgradation of AYUSH Hospital. The status of proposal received and approved for setting up of upto 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital and upgradation of AYUSH Hospital is furnished at **Annexure-III (a) and III (b) respectively**.

The Government has received various proposals to open/upgrade Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani (ASU) colleges/institutions, State/UT-wise in the country. The detail is given at **Annexure-IV**.

The details of new Homoeopathy colleges established in the year 2017-18 are given at **Annexure-V**. The status of proposals received and approved for setting up or upgradation of AYUSH Educational Institutions is attached at **Annexure-VI**.

(e): The details of funds earmarked, allocated/released and utilized for different activities of National AYUSH Mission including setting up of upto 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital and upgradation of AYUSH Hospital during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise is furnished at **Annexure-VII**.

(f): The Standing Finance Committee of the Ministry of AYUSH in its meeting held on 20th March, 2017 recommended for establishment of :- (i) All India Institute of Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy at Goa as an extension of the existing All India Institute of Ayurveda, New Delhi; (ii) National Institute of Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy at Panchkula(Haryana) as an extension of the existing National Institute of Ayurveda, Jaipur; (iii) National Institute of Homoeopathy at New Delhi as an extension of the existing National Institute of Homoeopathy, Kolkata and (iv) National Institute of Unani Medicine at Ghaziabad as an extension of the existing National Institute of Unani Medicine, Bangalore. These institutes in addition to providing medical health care services will also impart education in the respective system.
