AGREEMENT OF NATURAL GAS IMPORT WITH JAPAN

(a) to (c): The Government of India has signed a Memorandum of Cooperation(MoC) with Government of Japan on 17th October, 2017 in Tokyo. The area of MoC includes establishing a liquid, flexible and transparent global Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) market. It is the first bilateral MoC exclusively on LNG cooperation.
