- (a) the details of industrial output in the country during the last one year and the current year, month-wise and sector-wise;
- (b) the growth of consumer demand during the above period; and
- (c) the reaction of the Government thereto and the efforts being made to revive the industrial output in the coming year?

- (a): The industrial performance measured in terms of Index of Industrial Production (IIP) reflects movements in production of manufacturing, mining and electricity over base year 2011-12. The details of industrial output in the country measured as per IIP and its growth for the last year and the current year, month-wise and sector-wise are given at Annexure-I.
- (b): The growth of consumer demand is reflected in the growth of the index of Consumer durables and Consumer non-durables in IIP. The details of growth of index of Consumer durables and Consumer non-durables in IIP as per use based classification, for the last one year and the current year, month-wise, are given at Annexure-II.
- (c): The Government is continuously taking steps to facilitate industrial production and growth. These inter-alia, include 'Make in India' initiative under which thrust sectors have been identified to provide a push to manufacturing in India, 'Startup India' initiative and 'Ease of Doing Business'. The Government aims at creating a conducive environment by streamlining the existing regulations and processes and eliminating unnecessary requirements and procedures. Further, Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) policy and procedures have been simplified and liberalised progressively.
