- (b) if so, the details thereof and the total number of beneficiaries of referral treatments from different hospitals during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the number of patients screened so far and the expenditure incurred therein during the said period, State/UT-wise; and
- (d) whether any private hospital has been de-empanelled for not complying to the guidelines and if so, the details thereof?
