NEW AREAS OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to open new areas of skill development training in addition to the traditional occupational training available to the ITIs throughout the country and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether the Government is extending its assistance to the State ITIs in terms of technical experts (trainers), machinery and fund etc. and if so, the details thereof?

(a) Directorate General of Training (DGT) has implemented “**Dual System of Training**” (DST) in ITIs across the country in year 2016. Dual System combines practical training in the industry and theoretical knowledge along with foundation practical in ITI(s) which leads to better ITI – Industry linkage. DST enables the ITI trainees to have exposure to latest trends in the industry.

The Dual System of Training is currently available in the following 16 trades:

- i. Electrician
- ii. Fitter
- iii. Machinist
- iv. Turner
- v. Electronics Mechanic
- vi. Welder
- vii. Mechanic Diesel
- viii. Mechanic (Motor Vehicle)
- ix. Cosmetology
- x. Tool & Die Maker (Dies & Moulds)
- xi. Draughtsman (Mechanical)
- xii. Attendant Operator (Chemical Plant)
- xiii. Mechanic Refrigeration and Air-conditioning
- xiv. Plumber
- xv. Automotive Body Repair
- xvi. Automotive Paint Repair

(b). Directorate General of Training is extending its assistance to State ITIs by implementing following schemes for upgrading Industrial Training Institute (ITIs) throughout the country:

1. The World Bank assisted Vocational Training Improvement Project (VTIP): The scheme, interalia, covers upgradation of 400 Government ITIs in 34 States/Union Territories. The Government of India has released Rs. 1233.30 crore under VTIP. Physical component of the scheme consist of setting of new classrooms, workshops and modernization of tools, equipment and machinery in ITIs. The scheme objective also includes enhancement of knowledge and skills of ITI instructors under ToT and strengthening facilities in 14 central institutes.

2. Upgradation of existing Government ITIs into Model ITIs: 26 Government ITIs have been covered for upgradation into model ITIs in 25 States. The Government of India has released Rs. 67.59crore under the scheme so far.

3. Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in NE States: The scheme envisages upgradation of 20 existing govt. ITIs by introducing of 3 new trades in each ITI and supplementing old and obsolete tools and equipment in each of 28 existing ITIs in 8 Northeastern States. An amount of Rs. 57.51 crore (100% centrally funded) has been released so far.
