Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any steps have been taken by the Government to include all national law universities in the list of institutions of national importance;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (d): The National Law Universities (NLUs) have been established under various State Acts and are administered by the respective State Governments. Any change in their status can only be initiated by the State Government concerned.

At present, there is no such proposal to grant them the status of Institutions of National Importance.
